

Cripps raise over £29,000 for Alzheimer's Research UK

A charity partnership between top 100 law firm Cripps and Alzheimer's Research UK (ARUK) has raised £29,230.

Over the past 12 months, staff at Cripps have undertaken various fundraising activities for ARUK with the biggest fundraiser being the South Coast Challenge, which involved a group of twelve individuals walking a combined 760km from Polegate to Arundel. This challenge alone raised over £4,100. Other activities included a photography competition, a charity quiz and staff donating an hour of pay.
